Womack, who has won multiple Grammy and Country Music Association awards during her career, will be joined on the bill by Keni Thomas and Cornbread, among other acts.

It's hard to imagine Freedom Festival organizers finding a more perfect fit for the Stadium of Fire theme than Thomas. Not only did he serve in the military -- earning the Bronze Star for Valor and the Combat Infantryman's Badge as an Army Ranger while fighting in the Somalian battle that was the basis for the book and motion picture "Black Hawk Down" -- but his debut album, "Flags of Our Fathers; A Soldier's Story" is culled from his unique military perspective.

"Every writer is influenced by life," Thomas said in a phone interview Thursday night from a Nashville recording studio. "Some people have gone through divorce, some people have gone through drinking and some people have gone through breakups. One of the things that I can talk about is stories I've learned from having been in the military, which is a unique thing. We actually did the whole record just for that."

Thomas enlisted the help of several big-name guest artists to appear on the record, including Kenny Rogers, Michael McDonald, Emmylou Harris and Vince Gill among others.

"Some (songs) were happy. Some were sad. Some were pretty motivational and some were just rockin'," Thomas said. "It was a concept record, because we knew that you wouldn't be able to do this for the rest of your career."

Thomas said the Stadium of Fire show will be his first performance in the Beehive State, noting it is a special thrill that it will also tie into his military background.

"Anything that has to do with veterans and the military, when they think of me to ask ... it's a privilege," he said. "I never take that for granted."

Womack has released seven albums, with "There's More
