She has continued to correspond with and send items to individual soldiers in Iraq and was overwhelmed when she received an antique, hand-carved jewelry box from a 21year-old Iraqi translator in Kirkuk, who also had received items from her.

Information about the program and a list of items to be collected will be posted in the library where a collection box will be located. Information will also be on the borough and library Web sites, and it will be listed in the borough's spring bulletin. Residents can learn more about the effort by visiting www.anysoldier.com.

Money to purchase items and cover shipping costs is also being accepted. Checks can be made out to the Whitehall Diamond Outreach and marked "Attn: Any Soldier Campaign."

Ms. Book said that volunteers, including local teens, will package the items for mailing this spring.

"We are very excited about this venture and are hoping to receive a good response from our residents," she said.
